It has been brought to our attention that you may have improperly disposed used engine oil on April 26, 1990. Used oil may be considered a hazardous waste if it displays any of the following characteristics: ignitable, corrosive, reactive, and/or E.P. toxic (containing pesticides, heavy metals or both) are considered hazardous waste and is regulated according to how it is handled or managed. Failure to comply with regulations could result in a large fine or prison sentence.
