Hello, Jim,

I reviewed your email, the map with the broken concrete marked on it, and the proposal from Fanning Excavating. They do not mention excavating or disturbing any soil; <u>if you will be moving soil, then we should talk further</u> about whether it's in an area that we know has contaminated soil remaining and how to handle that.

If you are not disturbing any soil, then you may proceed with your work. We will log your June 12, 2024 email as your notification to DNR that you will be repairing/replacing parts of the cap. It's too bad that part of the cap has broken concrete already, but very good that that area will soon be paved over and impermeable again.

Please keep in mind the following:

- The area you've marked with the broken concrete is part of the required cap for the 602 W Madison parcel; see the attached cap map. The approved cap maintenance plan (pages 10-22 of the January 3, 2024 DNR closure letter) indicates that the cap will be a minimum of 4" thick.
- The building is not part of the cap. We are not aware that there is any contaminated soil
  under the building. I hope you won't have any unpleasant surprises there, but if you do
  find any contamination in a new area, you will need to report it to DNR without delay.
  (That would likely require some soil sampling, but let's cross that bridge if we come to
  it.)
- The Fanning Excavation proposal mentions the canopy bases; if that refers to the canopy between Madison Avenue and the building, that area is also part of the required cap.

Once the cap is restored, <u>send photos of the completed work and a map showing the area to me within 60 days of completing the work.</u>

Thanks for following the advance notice requirement and for getting the cap back into good condition. Happy to answer any questions you have.
