

Dear Mr. Saari:

Earth Remediation Services (ERS) presents this Quarterly Progress Report as required by Administrative Order No. NWD-92-023. The following actions were completed in late 1993 and early 1994:

- \* The WDNR was provided with a Remedial Action Plan,
- \* Groundwater sampling and review associated analytics,
- \* At the request of the WDNR an addendum was prepared and attached to the Remedial Action Plan to include groundwater remediation by converting monitoring well MW-2 into a recovery well at the WDNR's request,
- \* Initialize an Annual Report which will include the third and forth groundwater sampling event results.

To reduce contaminants to WDNR prescribed levels, ERS plans to install a recovery pump and remove a calculated eight pore volumes of groundwater. The system will be installed in either April or May (after any possible freezing weather conditions have past). The system will include air diffusion to remediate the recovered groundwater as noted in the January 4, 1994 letter to the WDNR. Since the interim action excavation in June, 1993; the levels in nearby MW-1 have been reduced by 75%. Although the levels have dropped in MW-2 as well, the GRO contamination is at 140 ppm with benzene greater than two ppm.
