

Following up on our conversation earlier this afternoon.

If we modify the scope as follows:

- One sub-slab sample from each occupied space, one sub-slab from the basement areas and one sample from each of the 4 sump pits = 10 total. (no duplicate or QA/QC samples)
- One ambient air sample from each occupied space plus outdoor background = 7 (no duplicate or QA/QC)
- Provide the property owner and DNR with analytical test results and brief memo (no formal report)

We think we can do this for less than \$10,000. The intent would be to follow up with a report at a later date based on available funds.

We would be pleased to discuss further following your internal meeting next week.
