Good Morning Tim,

DNR has reviewed the site information, and agrees that the immediate risk of vapor intrusion should be priority, however PFAS sampling cannot be waived and requests that PFAS sampling be completed within the next year.

DNR recommends obtaining groundwater samples from two sampling points, at a minimum, within the source area (i.e. MW-1 and MW-3 or MW-6) during the next groundwater monitoring event. If PFAS is detected in the source area, then additional investigation may be needed.
