Dear Ms. Richardson:

On August 21, 1991, the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) notified you of your responsibility to investigate and, as needed, clean up contamination located at the above-referenced property. This site was eligible for funding under the Petroleum Environmental Clean-up Fund Act (PECFA) Program. The PECFA Program ended on June 30, 2020. Because of the impending PECFA deadline, the site was briefly discussed on June 30, 2020, and it was determined monitoring wells (MW-2, MW-3, EX-8 and EX-9) could be abandoned to prepare for asphalt installation and a complete closure packet would need to be submitted before a closure decision could be made. As of this date, the DNR has not received a complete closure packet. As owner of this property you have certain legal responsibilities, as outlined in Section 292.11(3), Wisconsin Stats., also known as the hazardous substances spills law. Section 292.11(3) states:

- *RESPONSIBILITY. A person who possesses or controls a hazardous substance which is discharged or who causes the discharge of a hazardous substance shall take the actions necessary to restore the environment to the extent practicable and minimize the harmful effects from the discharge to the air, lands or waters of the State.*

Wisconsin Administrative Code chapters NR 700 through NR 749 establish requirements for emergency and interim actions, public information, site investigations, design and operation of remedial action systems, and case closure. Wisconsin Administrative Code chapter NR 140 establishes groundwater standards for contaminants that reach groundwater.
