Dear Tim:

As I mentioned in my email of June 11, 2013, the Village of Ridgeland contacted me last week and informed me our monitoring well MW-6 or PZ-1 (see attached site map) slightly damaged the sewer lateral for the Pat Amundson residence. The Village has paid for the sewer to be flushed out several times. The sewer appears to be intact but must have been cracked. The exact location and depth of the sewer lateral is still unknown.

Before installing this test well, we completed the following efforts to locate the utilities in this area:

1. Contacted Digger's Hotline (Ticket No.20112209841)
2. Spoke with Village official (Lowell Weber) by phone and sent letter (copy attached).
3. Spoke with property owner (Mrs. Amundson)
4. Met with Village Sewer technician (Mike) who provided copy of sewer plans (attached). Sewer was installed in late 1950's.

Last week (June 13), I met with the Village official (Lowell Weber), Mrs. Amundson, and Brian Wirth of Wirth Bros. (local contractor who installs/repairs sewers in Village). They all agreed we could not have known the sewer lateral had been installed in this unusual configuration. Most sewer laterals go from the house straight out to the sewer main. Mrs. Amundson thinks the lateral was installed by hand in the late 1950's or early 1960's.

Brian Wirth (Wirth Bros) estimated the repair cost will be \$500 provided the sewer is readily accessible. We are going to wait until August to allow the water table to drop allowing easier and safer access to the sewer. Costs could be higher if it continues to be a wet summer and if the lateral is buried deep.

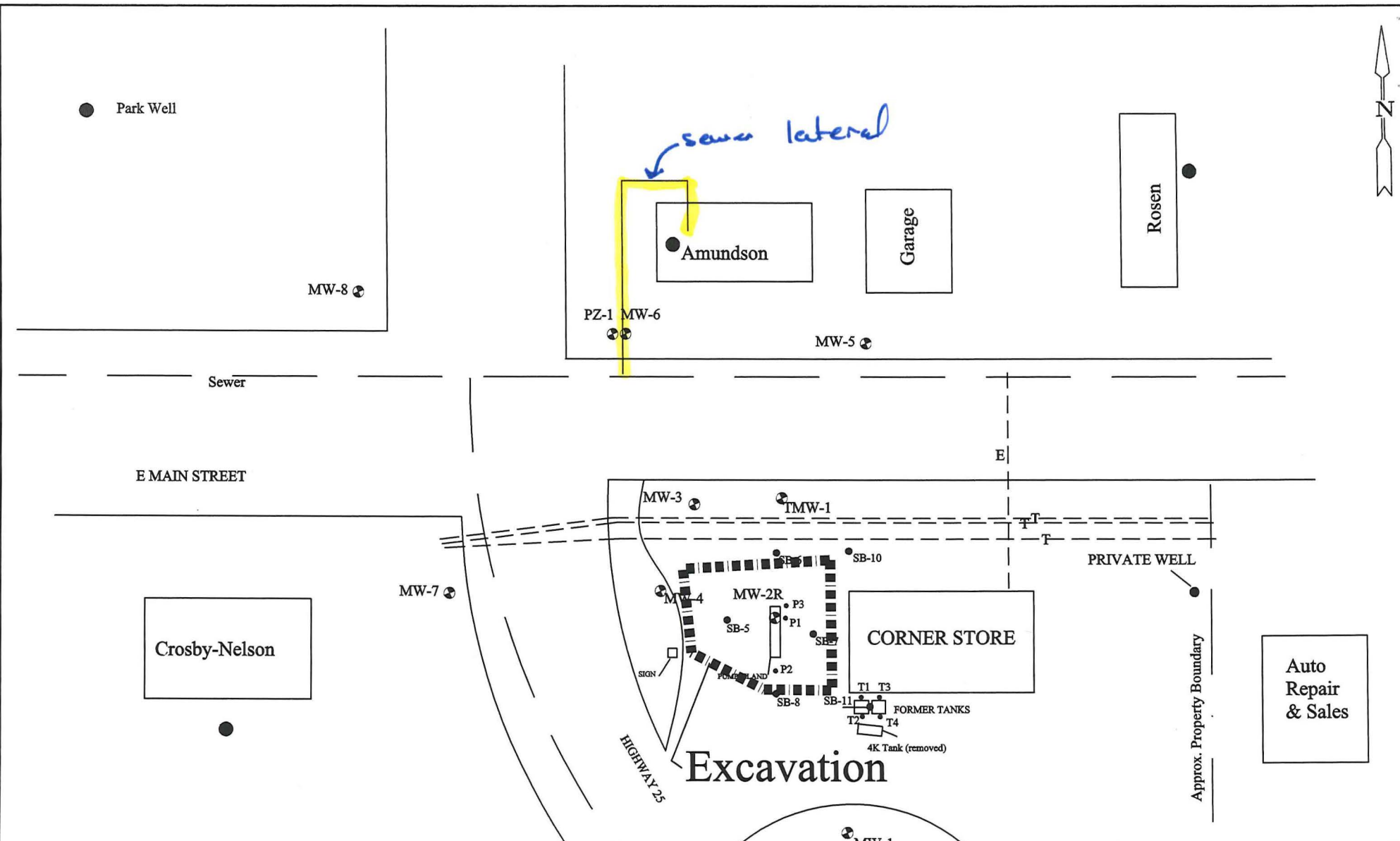
Any help from PECFA for the repair cost would be greatly appreciated.

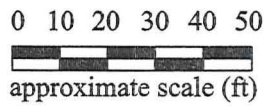

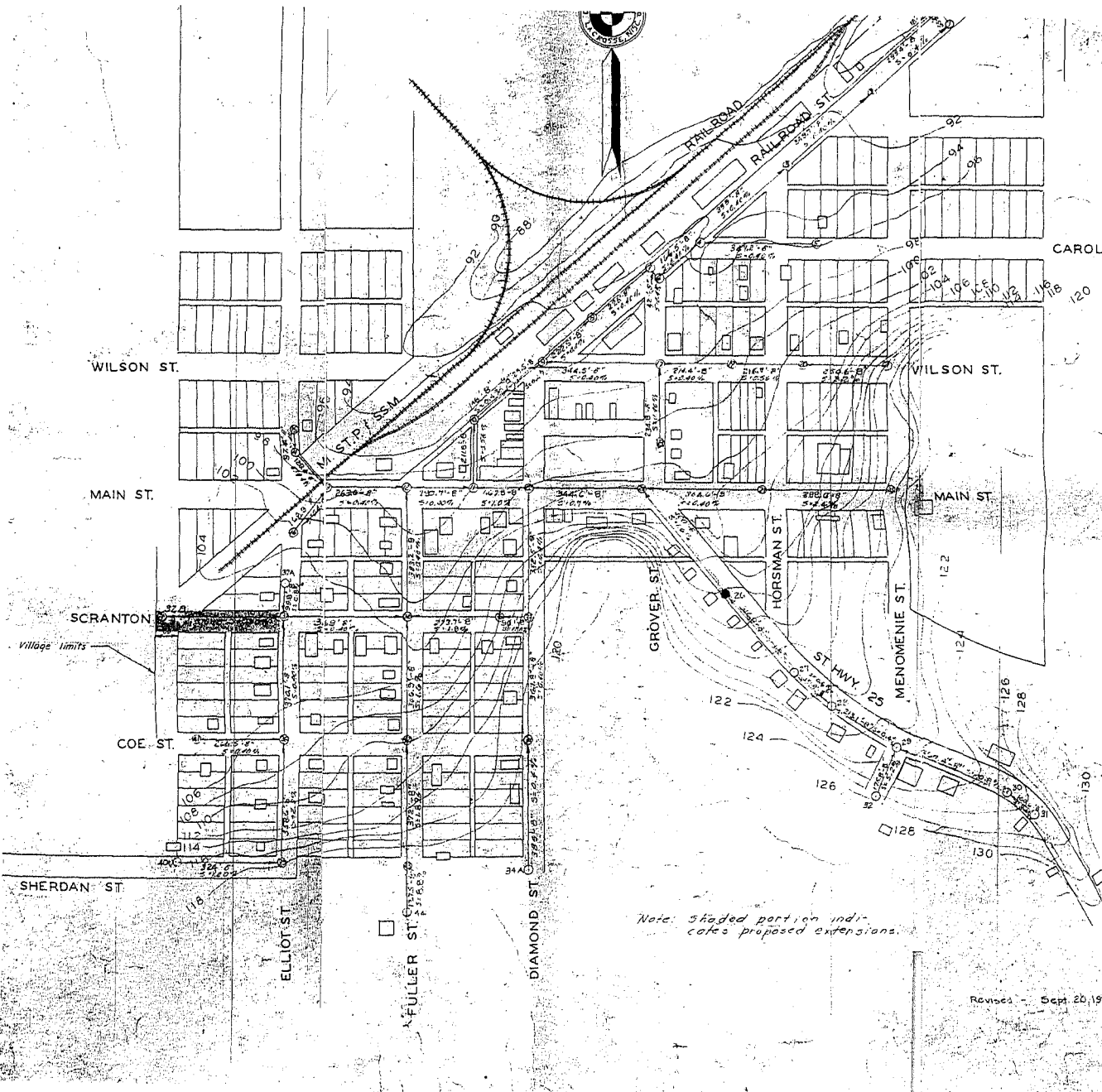
Legend
