On October 09, 2013, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (Department) received a scope of work (SOW) and cost estimate utilizing the SPS 347, Wisconsin Administrative Code, Usual and Customary Cost Schedule (Cost Schedule) for the site referenced above.
