Dear Mr. and Mrs. Gruichich:

I received a copy of a letter from Enviromental Professionals  
Lts. which was dated November 10, 1994. The letter was addressed  
to Kristine Buettner, my former name. My married name is now  
Kristine Hein.

This letter is in error, since I never requested a review of  
various subsurface reports regarding groundwater quality at the  
site of the Redy-Quick Cleaners by Environmental Professionals Ltd.  
I see that the name of your son, Sam Gruichich, appears as a "cc"  
on the letter from Environmental Professionals. Sam may have  
initiated the request to Environmental Professionals.

As you know, my mother retained Miller Engineers of Sheboygan  
to remove underground tanks at the property and to address  
contamination which may have been caused by petroleum products  
stored in those tanks. According to Miller Engineers and the DNR,  
this work is now nearing completion.

The present contamination at the property now involves  
chlorinated compounds, as described in the letters from the  
Wisconsin DNR dated June 28, and December 7, 1994. As stated in  
DNR's letter dated December 7, 1994, the chlorinated compound  
contamination is related to dry cleaning activity and is your  
responsibility. The present contamination at the property is not  
the responsibility of my mother.

Please be advised that my mother and I have no objection to  
your proceeding with response activities at the property with  
regards to the chlorinated compounds. We will cooperate in this  
matter in any way we can. However, my mother is not in a financial  
position to assume responsibility for any costs associated with an  
environmental investigation and/or remediation at this property  
related to chlorinated compounds.
