The Department of Natural Resources (DNR) considers the McGlynn Property case closed. No further investigation or remediation is required at this time. Provide this letter to anyone who purchases this property.

This final closure decision is based data available to the DNR and is issued under Wis. Adm. Code chapter NR 726. The DNR's South Central Region Closure Committee reviewed the case and determined this closure decision complies with state laws and is consistent with the closure of similar cases.

The case was opened in 1990 due to evidence of petroleum contamination at the old gas station on the property. No additional environmental work was performed for decades and the property was tax delinquent for many years. The DNR recently hired a contractor to remove the four underground tanks at the site and evaluate the environmental conditions. No contamination was found.

The case may be reopened pursuant to Wis. Adm. Code section NR 727.13, if additional information regarding site conditions indicates contamination on or from the site poses a threat to public health, safety, or welfare or to the environment.
