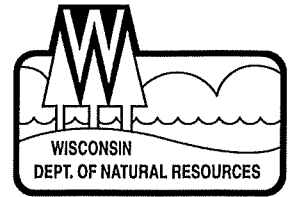

Dear Mr. Burmeister:

I have received your January 30, 2020 response to the required *Notification of Continuing Obligations and Residual Contamination* sent to Marinette County. It has been proposed that the residual soil contamination in its current location, more than 5 feet below the ground surface, is not a threat to human health or the environment. It has been shown that the contaminant concentration will continue to degrade over time. The liability for that soil contamination belongs to the owner of W8317 CTH P.
