On April 08, 2019, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (Department) received a scope of work (SOW) and cost estimate utilizing the chapter NR 747, Wisconsin Administrative Code, Usual and Customary Cost Schedule (Cost Schedule) for the site referenced above.

The Department has determined that the submitted SOW is reasonable and **approves** the additional costs. This site will be deferred from the public bidding process at this time. The Department will contact you if this site will be bid in the future.

This approval is for the installation of a monitoring well/piezometer nest and includes (4) rounds of groundwater sampling (VOCs 1st round, PVOC + Naphthalene $2^{nd} - 4^{th}$ rounds). Please supply raw labs after the 2^{nd} round. A soil sample (PVOC + Naphthalene) from the piezometer installation will be taken at the groundwater table. Groundwater sampling shall be concurrent with sampling previously approved on April 5, 2019. A copy of the Department worksheet for the Cost Schedule tasks is enclosed for your reference.
