Dear Mr. Noonan:

On June 19, 2015, Taylor County took possession of the property-mentioned above via tax foreclosure and therefore, qualified for the Local Governmental Unit (LGU) exemption, which means a local governmental unit is not responsible for investigating or cleaning up hazardous substances, including contaminated soil and groundwater. However, the closure fees have been paid and I would like to keep this site moving forward towards closure. This site was eligible for funding under the Petroleum Environmental Clean-up Fund Act (PECFA) Program, which ended on June 30, 2020. Because of the impending PECFA deadline, the site was briefly discussed on June 26, 2020, and it was determined all the monitoring wells and piezometers could be abandoned, but revisions to the closure packet were needed. As of this date, the DNR has not received a revised closure packet.
