Hi Ken,

Further information is requested. This email is serving as a Pause notification, and is the only written communication (no follow-up letters) will be forthcoming from the Department of Natural Resources as part of the Pause process. The Pause designation means that you have sixty (60) days from the date of this email (December 1, 2016) to address the requested items. If the issues are not addressed – then the site status would revert to open status and a new closure request with the required DNR fees would be needed again in order to have it reviewed for closure.

The following specific administrative issues need to be addressed prior to the expedited review in order for the site to proceed to the next step which should be a Remaining Actions Needed letter stipulating the abandonments of groundwater monitoring wells (and documentation) in order to achieve case closure status.

• Key administrative steps include revising the maps to include soil and groundwater contamination on the source property, and then a Letter Notification to the Village of Radisson informing the Village of residual soil and groundwater contamination in the Martin Street and Martin Street Right-Of-Way (ROW) from the Adams Garage property. The Village has thirty days to reply to the Letter Notification – however, the Village can inform the DNR in writing sooner than thirty days, if they have no comments or issues, effectively reducing the timeframes.

Please adjust the Closure Request and GIS Registry Packet accordingly to submit the new information requested in this Pause e-mail. A copy of the revised GIS Registry and updated CD-ROM should be mailed to me. The revisions can be emailed to me as long as the updated CD-ROM is mailed. Upon submittal of this information the case will be expeditiously reviewed. Thanks for your continued patience, it is very much appreciated.
