On October 13, 2017, the Northeast Regional Closure Committee reviewed your request for closure of the case described above. The Regional Closure Committee reviews environmental remediation cases for compliance with state rules and statutes to maintain consistency in the closure of these cases. On October 24 and November 28, 2017, the Department requested revisions to the closure packet to be completed by your consultant, Mr. Joe Ramcheck of Endeavor Environmental Services. The revisions, to be included on the Department's GIS Registry, were received on November 13 and 28, 2017. The following actions are needed to complete our review of your request. Upon completion of these actions, closure approval will be provided.

## Remaining Actions Needed

### Monitoring Well Abandonment

## Purge Water, Waste and Soil Pile Removal

Any remaining purge water, waste and/or soil piles generated as part of site investigation or remediation activities must be removed from the site and disposed of or treated in accordance with the applicable rules. Once that work is completed, please send appropriate documentation regarding the treatment or disposal of the remaining purge water, waste and/or soil piles.

## Documentation

When the required actions have been completed, submit the appropriate documentation within 30 days of the date of this letter, to verify their completion. At that point, your closure request can be approved and your case can be closed. The submittal of both an electronic and paper copy are
