Dear Mr. Draxler:

On October 29, 2002 your site as described above was reviewed for closure by the Department of Natural Resources. The Department reviews environmental remediation cases for compliance with state laws and standards to maintain consistency in the closure of these cases.

On September 26, 2002, the Department received correspondence indicating that you have complied with the conditions of closure. Soil remediation was performed by excavation, bioremediation and reuse. Approximately 1 cubic yard of contaminated sandy foundation soils remain below the building foundation and cannot practically be excavated. Considering this is a minimal amount of remaining soils with minimal risk to the environment and human health, the Department does not require that the site be placed on the Department's Soil GIS Registry. Based on the correspondence and data provided, it appears that your case has been remediated to Department standards in accordance with s. NR 726.05, Wis. Adm. Code. The Department considers this case closed and no further investigation, remediation or other action is required at this time. If the contaminated soils become accessible, then further remediation may be required at that time.

Please be aware that this case may be reopened pursuant to s. NR 726.09, Wis. Adm. Code, if additional information regarding site conditions indicates that contamination on or from the site poses a threat to public health, safety or welfare, or the environment.
