Nine Springs Environmental Consultants, Inc. (Nine Springs) is pleased to present this spill response letter report on behalf of Trism, Inc. (Trism), Tri-State Motor Transit Co. (Tri-State). The report describes the activities associated with the perchloroethylene (PCE) release that occurred at the Klinke Cleaners facility at 412 East Washington Avenue, Madison, Wisconsin on November 3, 2000 and requests closure for the subject release site.

Nine Springs was notified of the PCE release at Klinke Cleaners by Mr. Donny Lester (Trism) on the afternoon of November 3, 2000. It was reported that a 30-gallon drum of waste PCE had accidentally been dropped down a flight of stairs at Klinke Cleaners and the PCE had been released onto the basement floor. Nine Springs personnel immediately mobilized to the spill site.

Prior to exposure to the PCE spill area, a gas powered ventilator was set up and fresh air was blown into the basement area. Level C personal protective equipment was used and a photoionization detector was set up to monitor the concentration of total volatile organic compounds (VOCs) in the breathing area.

Granular absorbent material was used to absorb the spilled PCE. The granular absorbent was subsequently swept into piles and then properly containerized. Special care had to be taken to insure that all of the released PCE was absorbed since there were numerous pieces of heavy equipment that had to be moved out of the way to gain access to the PCE on the floor. Once the equipment had been moved from the release area it became evident that the PCE had flowed into a sump pit area that was covered with two metal plates. The steel plates were moved aside and the sediment present in the sump pit was observed to be saturated with PCE. Hand excavation of the sump pit was started on November 3, 2000 and was completed on November 6, 2000.

The PCE contaminated absorbent material and sediment were containerized in four 55-gallon drums. Trism stated that they would be responsible for the transportation and proper disposal of the contaminated material. The four drums were temporarily stored on site pending transfer to the designated disposal facility. Trism coordinated for Tri-State to transport the four 55-gallon drums to WRR Environmental Services Co., Inc. in Eau Claire, Wisconsin. The disposal documentation was provided to Nine Springs on January 19, 2001. The following items are included in Appendix A:

There were no confirmation soil samples collected during the spill response activities based on a telephone conversation between Mr. Ted Amman, Spill Coordinator for the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources South Central Region, and Sam Cooke of Nine Springs.

Based on the spill response activities and the proper disposal of the PCE contaminated soil and absorbent material at WRR Environmental Services Co., Inc., Nine Springs respectfully requests that the PCE spill site at the subject Klinke Cleaners facility be granted closure, as appropriate. 
