This email follows our telephone conversation last Friday (15<sup>th</sup>) in which we discussed the Soil and GW Inv. Rpt submitted in July for the Julson Store (former) site south of Mondovi. In that report, I recommended we complete an interim remedial excavation this fall followed by test wells and monitor to closure.

DNR staff determined that more Site Investigation is needed before a remedial option should be considered and approved. Subsequently, I will send you a revised Change Order/Work Plan to install 2-inch monitoring wells in order to define the extent of impacted ground water and characterize the aquifer properties (e.g., hydraulic conductivity, ground water flow direction (horizontal, vertical), etc). I will also install additional soil borings (and sampling) to more precisely define the extent of impacted soil.

Our goal is to complete the SI work through the winter so that a remedial option can-may be implemented next summer ... which is-may be needed to complete this project before the upcoming PECFA deadline.

Please let me know if you have any additional comments about the project.

Will send you CO/WP shortly.
