After reviewing the file it appears that the Site Investigation has been completed and approved by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (Department or DNR). See attached PDF dated April 1, 2015. An application for Cost Reimbursement was approved on March 3, 2016, and payment was made shortly after that. That is where the site is as of now.

The next phase for the Dutch Cleaners site is the remedial action phase of the cleanup. The eligible applicant or their agent will need to submit proposals for this phase of work (a minimum of three bids) to the Department, as well as a request for approval for the one that is selected. The Department will review the proposals to see if the one selected is reasonable (i.e., is the proposal responsive to the site conditions, is the scope of their bid complete, and are costs within the "norm" of the other bids). If the recommended proposal is agreeable, the Department will send a letter back or sign at the bottom of the proposal form, so remedial activities can proceed. If the proposal is not acceptable, the Department will let the applicant know why and have them resubmit their information after they address any concerns.

The applicant or agent can submit reimbursement applications twice per fiscal year once they reach the remedial action stage, based on their choice of when they want reimbursement.
