
Dear Mr. Getz:

We have reviewed the document, "Work Plan Addendum", which was submitted on your behalf by your environmental consultant, Sigma Environmental on March 11, 2002. In this document, Sigma presents a proposal for additional investigation at the above referenced site, which they estimate to cost \$13,493 more than the previous estimate for the subsurface investigation. The additional investigation is required because for the investigation to be considered complete, a survey of the storm and sanitary sewers must be conducted, an additional monitoring well needs to be installed and soil delineation within the building is necessary.

Based on the information provided, we approve the proposal for the additional investigation, and the proposal for the additional costs associated with the investigation. Please note, that though we approve the costs of the additional costs of the investigation, it is still the responsibility of the your environmental consultant to make sure that all DERP eligibility rules are being followed.

In the future, please submit all bid proposals investigative or remedial action work on the "Dry Cleaner Environmental Response Program Bid Proposals Summary", Form 4400-212.
