Fort James Operating Company, Green Bay West Unleaded Gasoline Spill – May 2, 2004

Dear Ms. Chronert:

RE:

On May 2, 2004 12:30 pm, our Ms. Katie Thomas notified the WDNR 24-hour Spill Hotline of an unleaded gasoline spill to soil. The release occurred when a crane struck a portable gasoline can with its front tire causing the can to rupture and spill approximately 2 gallons of unleaded gasoline onto the ground. The discharge specifics are as follows:

- Date of Discharge May 2, 2004
- Time of Discharge 11:40 am
- Location of Discharge Fort James Operating Company, Green Bay West Mill
- Identity of Material Unleaded Gasoline
- Amount Released 2 gallons (estimate) to soil
- Cause of Release Crane struck gasoline can
- Impacts The impact was to soil only. The nearest waterway is several hundred feet away.
- Weather Conditions 15° F, Moderate Winds, No Precipitation
- Containment, Cleanup and Disposal The release was contained and immediately soaked up with absorbent material and containerized for disposal. The material will be disposed of in a licensed landfill.
- Corrective Action Review portable container storage with affected personnel and consider alternate means to fuel portable equipment.




