John & Bruce,

Per our discussion on January 16, 2019, there are a few additional items that need to be addressed before the previously implemented deed notice requirements can be extinguished, due to the soil sample collected from HP-1 at 12-16' having PVOOC + N concentrations significantly higher than those reported at the time of closure.

- Vertical definition of soil contamination at or near HP-1
- Additional horizontal definition south of HP-1

If additional samples are collected and show that the soil contamination in HP-1 is an isolated area, then we should be able to extinguish both the cap requirement and groundwater use restriction (which shouldn't have been there in the first place).

Once the additional data is collected, just submit that to the department as an addendum to your original request. An additional fee will not necessary.
