On December 3, 2018 you submitted a post closure modification request for the Clear Lake Circle C site. The request was reviewed by the Department on December 18, 2018. An email requesting additional information was sent to your consultant (SEH Inc.) on January 16, 2019, a copy of which is attached. Our files indicate that we have not received any written correspondence or reporting for the case since the request for additional information. In order to get this case back on track please have your consultant prepare and submit documentation on the status of this case. If you do not have a consultant, please notify the department in writing within the next thirty days as to your intentions to submit the requested documentation.

**ACTIONS NEEDED**

As requested in the January 16, 2019 email, the following actions needed to be addressed.

- Vertical definition of soil contamination at or near HP-1
- Additional horizontal definition south of HP-1

Within the next 30 days, by **August 16, 2021**, please provide a status update. **If we do not hear from you by this time the post closure modification will be documented as not approved.**

John & Bruce,

Per our discussion on January 16, 2019, there are a few additional items that need to be addressed before the previously implemented deed notice requirements can be extinguished, due to the soil sample collected from HP-1 at 12-16' having PVOC + N concentrations significantly higher than those reported at the time of closure.

- Vertical definition of soil contamination at or near HP-1
- Additional horizontal definition south of HP-1

If additional samples are collected and show that the soil contamination in HP-1 is an isolated area, then we should be able to extinguish both the cap requirement and groundwater use restriction (which shouldn't have been there in the first place).

Once the additional data is collected, just submit that to the department as an addendum to your original request. An additional fee will not necessary.
