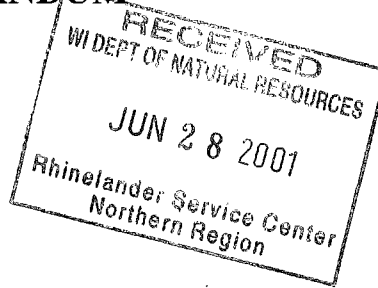

I received a note from Janet on the need for a memorandum to close this case administratively. My note indicated that the case was to be closed per John Robinson's direction. In order to expedite this closure, I have included the text of a memo I had written May 25, 2001, which was enclosed with my original request:

Dave Smith of Superior, Water, Light and Power called Hosch. Smith stated that he thought the spill occurred at Barkers Island. Smith stated that the records he had that the spill occurred in June of 1989, matched the Department's records of June 5, 1989. Smith stated that while digging they hit a fiberglass fuel line from a storage tank at the marina. Smith stated that the line was not under pressure so a minimal amount of fuel was lost. Smith stated that Warden Joe Davidowski gave permission for the spill to evaporate overnight. According to Smith, Davidowski and him came back the next day and checked the spill, and that Davidowski stated that clean up was adequate. Smith asked if Hosch needed any additional information. Hosch stated that would be fine for now.

Hosch stated that there was another case that he would need a contact name for. Hosch explained that there was contamination at the former MGP site in Superior. Smith indicated that Hosch should contact Roger Ingall at 395-6230.

As most of us are aware, under normal procedures and manual code this case should have never been opened as it was apparently closed by the Warden. That is all of the information available to me regarding the case. I hope this memorandum is sufficient to meet the needs of all concerned.
