Just a reminder that even though you are working through an agreement with GLNPO on the sediment remediation, all sediment work conducted at the site will also need to comply with the requirements of NR700 Wisconsin Administrative Code. I mention this because we have had projects where the responsible party misunderstood the process and were under the impression that because the project was being conducted under a GLNPO agreement, the NR700 process did not apply.
