Your proposed change order is approved. You may proceed with the proposed work. The DNR received the proposal titled, "Change Order Request for Sub-Slab Vapor Sampling and Analysis", prepared by United Engineering Consultants, Inc. (UEC) and submitted on your behalf on February 8, 2019.

The scope of work consists of:

- Installing five (5) vapor pins and sampling and analysis of the sub-slab vapor points in the building at the locations indicated in the attached Figure: Existing and Proposed Sub-Slab Vapor Sample Location Map of the Change Order request.
- The samples will be analyzed for the presence of Volatile Organic Compounds (VOCs) utilizing method TO-15.
- Reporting of the results.

Cost approval for this change order (UES 2.8.19) is \$1,500.00 for consulting and \$1,800 for sub-contractors, for a total of \$3,300.00. The total cost approved to date for this site is \$71,449.00.

Please be aware that you are required to comply with all applicable statutes and administrative rules including the NR 700 series, Wisconsin Administrative Code, hazardous waste management and wastewater discharges.

This approval does not guarantee the reimbursement of costs under the Dry Cleaner Environmental Response Program. Final determination regarding the eligibility of costs for reimbursement will be made at the time of claim review.
