Thank you for submitting the Ordinary High Water Mark (OHWM) Determination letter report dated January 26, 2021. The report is approved, Tecumseh may use the report to support the work for the Remedial Action Standards Documentation Report as required under the HARP Negotiate Agreement.

The OHWM Determination report modeled the OHWM at HARP using department marked field locations where the OHWM was identified. The modeled OHWM is suitable for use in the Remedial Action Standards Documentation Report. However, the department reserves the right to perform additional field determination of the OHWM for the purpose of interpreting field data on sediment and soil chemistry, environmental standards related to the project, or for any other purpose related to water regulations or the Negotiated Agreement.

The Ordinary High Water Mark model results presented in this report are for use in the Remedial Action Standards Documentation Report and are not intended for any other use and do not substitute for property specific OHWM determinations by the department for projects or actions that require such determinations.
