On March 29, 2018, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (Department) received a scope of work (SOW) and cost estimate utilizing the chapter NR 747, Wisconsin Administrative Code, Usual and Customary Cost Schedule (Cost Schedule) for the site referenced above.

The Department has determined that the submitted SOW is reasonable and **approves** the additional costs. This site will be deferred from the public bidding process at this time. The Department will contact you if this site will be bid in the future.

On March 15 and March 29, 2018, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (Department) received original quote and then an upgraded scope of work (SOW) and cost estimates utilizing the chapter NR 747, Wisconsin Administrative Code, Usual and Customary Cost Schedule (Cost Schedule) for the site referenced above.

The Department has determined that the submitted SOW is reasonable and **approves** the additional costs. This site will be deferred from the public bidding process at this time. The Department will contact you if this site will be bid in the future.

Costs are approved for direct push technology soil sampling to define the degree and extent of the contaminated soil mass for the source property at 26514 Minnow Ave N in Webster. In addition, costs have been included in this PECFA budget cost approval for evaluating an existing soil pile on the Hoffman Corners/Hoffman Oil (former) (DNR BRRTS# 03-07-000115) for potential use as backfill for the Burnett Oil Company anticipated remedial excavation. Burnett County Government is the Responsible Party for both of these PECFA sites. The primary mob/demob (Consultant) for direct push technology is for the Burnett Oil Company with a primary mob/demob for hand augering (Consultant) for the soil pile on Hoffman Corners property a couple of blocks away. An incremental mob/demob (Consultant) for the GP mobilization for the Hoffman Corners property is included with this costs approval. The lab costs are approved as itemized in the spreadsheet. In addition, the variance costs request for lab charges for two soil samples to be analyzed for RCRA Metals Analyses (Lab Quote) is approved. A copy of the Department worksheet for the Cost Schedule tasks is enclosed for your reference.

Be reminded that ch. NR 700 semi-annual progress reporting is required until this case is closed.

Note: A claim for PECFA reimbursement must be submitted within 180 days of incurring costs (i.e., completing a task). If a claim for costs incurred is not submitted within this deadline, the costs will not be eligible for PECFA reimbursement. If you need assistance with filing your claim, please contact Tim Prosa at (608) 261-7715.

Usual and customary costs for activities included in this approval of \$2,730.36 will only be reimbursed at a rate equal to or less than what is allowed on the Cost Schedule, and are reimbursed based upon the Cost Schedule that is in effect at the time the activity is performed. Costs for activities not included in this approval are not reimbursable without prior Department authorization.

Regulatory Correspondence (Task 7, Activity RC05), Claim Submittal (Task 27, Activity CS05) and Standardized Invoice (Task 28, Activity SI05) costs are not included in the cap approved above. These activities will be reimbursed according to the task specifications and with submittal of proper supporting documentation at claim review time.

The Department approves a variance from the Cost Schedule for RCRA Metals Analyses in the amount of \$138.00 (two soil samples at \$69.00 each). Do not include these approved variance costs of \$138.00 on the standardized invoice for usual and customary cost activities. Include these costs on a separate company invoice. When you submit the claim for these costs, please attach a copy of this letter and the attached worksheet for the claim reviewer's reference. The Department waives the commodity three-bid requirement with this variance approval.

The Department considers the consultant the primary controller of costs during these activities. This approval does not guarantee eligibility of any specific costs that have been incurred or that may be incurred in the future. Final determination regarding the eligibility of costs will be made by the claim reviewer when the entire claim, including all invoices and reports, is submitted for payment.






