Dear Mr. Han:

On November 7, 2001, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) notified you of your legal responsibilities under Wisconsin Statute (Wis. Stat.) § 292.11 to investigate the degree and extent of the hazardous substance discharge on the above-referenced site. The DNR understands that an off-site vapor intrusion investigation has been conducted. However, the site investigation needs to be completed as required under Wis. Admin. Code ch. NR 716. The DNR requests that a workplan to continue the site investigation be submitted by July 15, 2023.

As the responsible party for this hazardous substance discharge, you have a legal responsibility under Wis. Stat. § 292.11 to investigate and clean up contamination resulting from the hazardous substance discharge. The DNR will work with you to move this site towards closure; however, this is the second request the DNR has made for information. If the above-requested information is not received by July 15, 2023, the DNR may initiate enforcement action against you for your failure to comply with Wis. Stat. ch. 292.

Your legal responsibilities are defined in statute and in administrative code. The hazardous substances spill law, Wis. Stat. § 292.11(3), states "A person who possesses or controls a hazardous substance which is discharged or who causes the discharge of a hazardous substance shall take the actions necessary to restore the environment to the extent practicable and minimize the harmful effects from the discharge to the air, lands, or waters of the state."

Wis. Admin. Code chs. NR 700 to NR 799 establish requirements for emergency and interim actions, public information, site investigations, design and operation of remedial action systems, and case closure.
