SUBJECT: Notice of Violation Enforcement Conference

Kringle Property, 609 W. Main St., Hortonville, WI

Dear Mr. Kringle:

On August 12, 1994, the Department of Natural Resources (Department) was informed that petroleum contamination was discovered during road construction on HWY 45 during July, 1994, at the above referenced location. dated August 25, 1994, the Department informed you of your legal responsibility as owner of the property, to investigate and clean-up the site. On April 11, 1995, the Department sent you a letter requesting information on the investigation/remediation of your site. On May 10, 1995, the Department sent you a "Notice of Non-Compliance" letter asking that you begin remediation efforts by May 24, 1995. As of this date, the Department has not been advised as to whether any remedial action(s) for the petroleum contamination has occurred.

Section 144.76(3), Wisconsin Statutes, requires that a person who possesses or controls a hazardous substance which is discharged shall take the actions necessary to restore the environment to the extent practicable. Department construes the failure to submit the requested information as failure to take appropriate action. Therefore, the Department alleges that you are in violation of s. 144.76(3), Stats.

The Department is very concerned about the lack of progress in this case. Department is requesting that either you and/or your consultant attend an enforcement conference on Tuesday, January 9, 1996, at 9:30 a.m. in the Oshkosh Area Office at 905 Bayshore Drive, Oshkosh, WI. A map is enclosed for your convenience. Please be prepared to discuss what action(s) will be taken to resolve this situation. If you fail to attend the meeting, the Department will consider further enforcement action.

Please be advised that violations under s. 144.76(3), Stats. are enforceable under s. 144.99, Stats., which provides for forfeitures of not more than \$5,000 for each violation.
