DNR is requesting an update as to the status of hiring an environmental consultant. On June 23, 2021, DNR sent you a letter notifying you of your responsibility to address the contamination that has migrated into the Right of Way adjacent to your property at 609 West Main St, in the Village of Hortonville, WI. The letter recommended you hire an environmental consultant by July 23, 2021, and to submit a Site Investigation Workplan by August 22, 2021.

Wisconsin Administrative Code § NR 700.11(1)(bm) states "... responsible parties shall submit a site investigation work plan meeting the requirements of s. [NR 716.09](#) to the department within 60 days of receiving notification that a site investigation is required.". To date the DNR has not received confirmation that you have hired an environmental consultant. As stated in the previous email and Responsible Party letter, please utilize the resource pages available at [DNR's Brownfields page](#) or myself as your assigned DNR project manager, for any issues or questions you have regarding these next steps.

DNR is requesting an update as to the progress of the above-mentioned items by October 15, 2021.
