On January 16, 2019, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (Department) received a scope of work (SOW) and cost estimate utilizing the chapter NR 747, Wisconsin Administrative Code, Usual and Customary Cost Schedule (Cost Schedule) for the site referenced above.

The Department has determined that the submitted SOW is reasonable and **approves** the additional costs. This site will be deferred from the public bidding process at this time.

Costs are approved for the remedial activities of soil excavation of contaminated soil and groundwater monitoring and includes petroleum vapor intrusion assessment activities. Estimate is for excavation of 1,330 tons of petroleum contaminated soil from the former Underground Storage Tank (UST) petroleum fuel delivery system area of concern and includes hauling, disposal at a landfill, backfill, and compaction. Proposed excavation area A is to ~8' depth to address soil above NR 720 soil to groundwater pathway RCLs, and proposed excavation area B is to ~4' depth to address soil above NR 720 direct contact RCLs (see figure). Staff Professional labor rates apply and are approved at \$94.13/hr for 44 hours of fieldwork. The proposed locations for soil borings and monitoring well locations are approved per the diagram submitted. Costs for confirmation soil sampling from the remedial excavation (up to 18) are approved; direct push technology sampling of soil and groundwater for confirmation purposes is approved. Monitoring well MW-1 (in excavation footprint) will be abandoned and replaced to 13-feet below ground surface (bgs) and costs are approved for these activities of well abandonment, boring, construction, and development of the replacement well. Costs for the installation of a new monitoring well downgradient of MW-3 to ~13 ft bgs depth are approved to define the degree and extent of the contaminant plume downgradient. Lead (Pb) is an addition as an analyte - in both soil and groundwater - to be assessed and those analytical costs are approved. Costs are approved for three post-excavation groundwater monitoring events from eight (8) monitoring wells and the on-site potable well for PVOC+Naphthalene+Lead. Total lab costs approved are \$2,655.42. Costs are also approved for surveying work. Costs are approved for vapor intrusion assessment activities. The Change Order Reguest is approved at the Usual & Customary Cost Schedule rate, and not per the variance 4 request. A copy of the Department itemized worksheet for the Cost Schedule and Variance tasks is enclosed for your reference.

Be reminded that ch. NR 700 semi-annual progress reporting is required until this case is closed.



Note: A claim for PECFA reimbursement must be submitted within 180 days of incurring costs (i.e., completing a task). If a claim for costs incurred is not submitted within this deadline, the costs will not be eligible for PECFA reimbursement. If you need assistance with filing your claim, please contact Tim Prosa at (608) 261-7715.

Usual and customary costs for activities included in this approval will only be reimbursed at a rate equal to or less than what is allowed on the Cost Schedule and reimbursed based upon the Cost Schedule that is in effect at the time the activity is performed. Costs for activities not included in this approval are not reimbursable without prior Department authorization.

Regulatory Correspondence (Task 7, Activity RC05), Claim Submittal (Task 27, Activity CS05) and Standardized Invoice (Task 28, Activity SI05) costs are not included in the cap approved above. These activities will be reimbursed according to the task specifications and with submittal of proper supporting documentation at claim review time.

The Department approves the variance requests as two variances submitted from the Cost Schedule. Variance 1 is approved in the amount of \$88,797.00 for excavation and removal of ~ 1,330 tons of petroleum-contaminated soils, mob/demob, fill/backfill and compaction, and rock as quoted by DKS, Inc. (Commodity provider) on 1/9/2019. Variance 2 for Excavation/Disposal Project (Consulting Variances - Page 3 request) costs are therefore approved based on \$94.13/hour for an estimated 44 hours at the Staff Professional labor rate. Project preparation and waste disposal documentation costs are approved at the \$94.13/hr Staff Professional Rate for eight hours. Project Management is approved for 6 hours at the Staff Professional \$94.13/hr wage rate. Variance 2 is for a combined approval of the two consulting variances requests (Page 3 of costs request) and includes the sub-total for consultant project management costs for Sub-Slab Vapor Sampling of 4 hours @\$94.13/hour = \$376.52. Sub-Slab Vapor Sampling activities are with the former service station building for TO-15 (PVOC + Naphthalene analyses) and the total amount for Consulting Variances (Page 3 of request) approved for Variance 2 is \$5,836.06. The other Variance request (Variance 3) for a Change Order Request (Qty - 1) is not approved as a variance, but instead per the Usual & Customary Cost Schedule for one Change Order Request. Do not include these total approved amount of variance costs of \$94,633.06 on the standardized invoice for usual and customary cost activities. Please include these approved variance costs for claim purposes on a separate company invoice. When you submit the claim for these costs, please attach a copy of this letter and the attached worksheet for the claim reviewer's reference. The Department waives the commodity three-bid requirement with this variance approval.

The Department considers the consultant the primary controller of costs during these activities. This approval does not guarantee eligibility of any specific costs that have been incurred or that may be incurred in the future. Final determination regarding the eligibility of costs will be made by the claim reviewer when the entire claim, including all invoices and reports, is submitted for payment.

At the request of the WDNR, a bid deferment (using Usual & Customary schedule of charges)/variance is being submitted for an excavation/disposal project, sub slab vapor sampling, and additional borings/monitoring wells and groundwater monitoring at the subject property located at 16571 STH 35 in Dairyland, Wisconsin. The cost estimate will include: [1] Conduct an excavation/disposal project to remove approximately 1,330 tons of petroleum impacted soils from the former UST system near MW-1, G-1, -2, -3, -13, and -16 to ~8 feet below ground surface (bgs) and and south to the area of Geoprobe borings G-4 & G-5 to ~4 feet bgs. Confirmation soil samples (up to 18) will be collected for PVOC+Naphthalene. [2] Geoprobe/Drilling Project: conduct two Geoprobe borings northwest and west of G-17 to 8 feet bas with two soil samples and one groundwater sample per boring for PVOC+ Naphthalene analysis. Reinstall monitoring well MW-1 (13 feet bgs) and install a new monitoring well down-gradient of monitoring well MW-3 to 13 feet bgs. [3] Surveying. [4] Conduct three post excavation groundwater monitoring events from all site monitoring wells (8 total) and on-site potable well for PVOC+Naphthalene analysis, [5] Conduct Sub Slab Vapor Sampling in the former service station for TO-15 (PVOC & Naphthalene) analysis. [6] Investigative Waste Disposal and [7] Two Letter Reports: one following the first post excavation groundwater sampling event and one following the last groundwater sampling event including the SSVS project. METCO is requesting a bid deferment/variance in the amount of \$112,872.83 to complete the above workscope. Upon state and client approval of the proposed workscope and budget, METCO will proceed with the project.

Please note that a second new well recommended south of monitoring well MW-5 does not appear warranted as the eastern edge (side-gradient) of the contaminant plume is defined by water samples collected from Geoprobe borings G-7, -21, & -24 and monitoring well MW-6. It should also be mentioned that the contaminant levels drop significantly from the source area to Geoprobe groundwater samples G-22-W & G-23-W.

At this time, our client does not want to have any borings done in the concrete pad nor to have any concrete removed as part of the excavation project unless the state would consider concrete replacement. Otherwise we will have to note the concrete pad as a "Structual Impediment".

Attached is a site layout map (with proposed excavation area, proposed down-gradient monitoring well location, and proposed sub slab vapor sampling locations), excavation cost estimates (was only able to obtain two competitive bids), consulting variance estimates, and draft standardized invoice form for the above workscope as required.

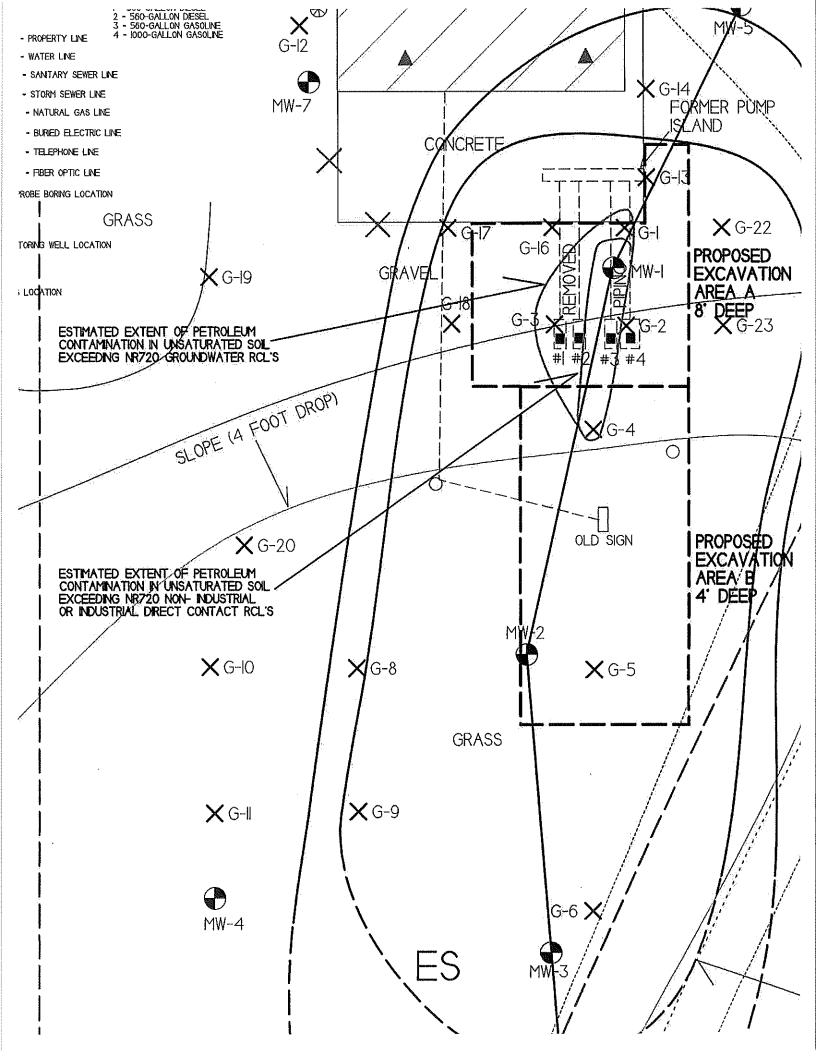
