The Department has received your November 18,1997 letter concerning the contaminated soil pile at the Finishing Touch site on South Park Street. The Department has been working the contractor for this site to arrange for final disposal of this waste material. Through a combination of delays concerning the nature of the waste material and delays on the part of the contractor this pile has remained on site for too long. The Department has recently sent a letter to the contractor concerning the proper disposal of the soil pile. With this additional information the Department believes the soil pile should off site in the next 2-3 weeks. Based on our discussions with the contractor, we believe there should be no more delays in dealing with this problem.



The Department has reviewed the analytical data for the tetrachloroethene contaminated soil pile at the Finishing Touch site at 501 South Park Street. Based on the information provided the Department has determined that the soils involved are not either a characteristic or listed hazardous waste and the material should be managed as a solid waste. This decision should help you expedite the removal and final disposal of these soils. The Department is very anxious to see these soil finally properly disposed of.
