Denice,

The DNR has reviewed the Wis. Admin. Code NR 718 Soil Management Plan submitted by Tyco on September 15, 2023, and is providing the following comments:

1. The request for a locational criteria exemption under Wis. Admin. Code § NR 718.05(2)(a) is granted. However, the DNR cannot approve your request for an exemption in duration under Wis. Admin Code NR 715.05(3) Requirements for Temporary Stockpiles. Should more than 15

days be required, then the general storage requirements under Wis. Admin Code § NR 718.05(4) must be met.

2. For future reference, all relevant standards must be included in the data tables.
3. All relevant documentation should be provided with the Wis. Admin. Code NR 718 Soil Management Plan including but not limited to field notes and photo logs.
4. Best management practices for stormwater control must be implemented at the site to mitigate any releases of contaminated surface water to the environment.
5. Following work completion, documentation of the material management activities shall be provided. The documentation must describe how the activities complied with the approved management plan and must also comply with the requirements of Wis. Admin. Code § NR 724.15(3). Including, but not limited to:
 - a. Maps, drawings, and/or cross sections that depict how contaminated material was managed.
 - b. A synopsis of the work conducted and an explanation as to how it complied with the material management plan.
 - c. A description of any changes made to the planned management activity and an explanation as to why they were necessary for the project.
 - d. Any field observations or results of monitoring conducted during the management activity.
 - e. A description of how new site conditions are protective of human health, safety, welfare and the environment.
 - f. Fieldnotes.
 - g. Waste Characterization Lab Data.
 - h. Photo Logs.
 - i. Waste Manifest.
