The former Gorski landfill is located a mile to the northwest of the City of Mosinee. As you may be aware, the groundwater in the vicinity of the Gorski landfill site has been contaminated by wastes disposed of at the landfill. Several water supply wells have been impacted by this contamination, with some wells being contaminated above health advisory levels. The degree and extent of the impacts from the Gorski landfill must be evaluated to determine the threat to the environment and to the residents in the area. Department records indicate that Weston Construction, Inc. (previously known as George Babl, Inc.) hauled waste to the Gorski landfill. This information leads us to believe Weston Construction, Inc., would be a potential responsible party (PRP) under the Federal Superfund law.

At this time the Department is asking the businesses and municipalities that disposed of waste at the Gorski landfill, along with waste haulers and the current and former owners of the Gorski landfill, to form a PRP group to cooperatively investigate the environmental contamination at this site. The Department intends to conduct an investigation at the Gorski landfill this summer. If those who disposed of waste at this landfill and other PRPs do not begin the required investigation in the near future, the Department will use Environmental Fund money to begin this work. However, the Department's policy is to seek cost recovery from responsible parties for any such expenditure.

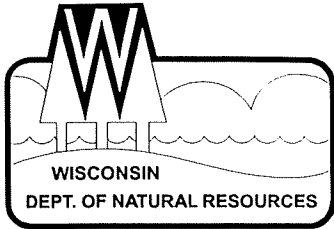
