EnviroForensics, LLC requests a time extension of two (2) weeks for delivery of the NR 716 Site Investigation Report (SIR) and revised Groundwater Monitoring Plan (GMP) that will accompany the SIR. The reason for extension is that we would like to sample the site monitoring wells one more time before reaching our conclusions. Twenty three additional groundwater monitoring wells were installed this past May, and were first sampled in early June. We are planning to sample the wells again the last week of August. It will take two (2) weeks for the laboratory analytical to be completed.

The original due date for the SIR and GMP is October 12, 2017. We wish to extend the due date to October 26, 2017.
