Hello Brian,

As discussed on the phone yesterday, I am following up with the DNR's decision with regards to the handling of soil material for the Meade Street utility work in Appleton, WI. Based on the information available, there does not appear to be a significant risk in placing the soil cuttings back in the trench after the utility lines are replaced. We looked at the soil and temporary monitoring well data that you provided and compared that to the adjacent Appleton Wire site data.

As you noted, the material has yet to be characterized by the City of Appleton and this may determine whether soil would be disposed of or placed back in trench, however the DNR is not requesting any special handling of material at this time. The DNR will continue working with consultants on a case-by-case basis for all future work and this decision should not be assumed to be the result for future projects.
