Jeff Paddock and I just got off a call with the PRP contractors for Wausau and they were alarmed by the worst-case scenario of gridding out the two industrial buildings at the Wausau Superfund Site. However, I think they understand that we're going to require sampling to ensure we aren't missing anything.

Quick recap – the goal is to develop a VI sampling plan that finally gathers enough data to 1. Determine where there is and isn't a VI issue, 2. Identify VI source areas, 3. Determine if/how to address the source/subslab vapors 4. Submit a focused feasibility study, proposed plan, and ROD Amendment that finalizes how VI will be addressed at the Site.

What would be most helpful now is for all of us to meet again to discuss exactly what we'd like them to do (how many samples and where) so that they can put a dollar figure to it and talk with their clients.

Jeff Paddock and Rob Hoverman, are there any days/times next week that y'all cannot meet? Once I know that I'll get a meeting set up based on everyone's calendars.
