At your request, we have compiled a few pictures from our recent observations in the dewatered canal adjacent to the Appleton MGP site. The pictures depict the sheen and small tar globules observed in some limited locations. As we have discussed, and as you saw during your site visit, the conditions depicted in these photos are more of a worst-case scenario, with much of the canal bottom being free from these conditions.
