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John: We sampled Minocqua Cleaners on Oct 26 and 27 and sending you the table summary as requested in the contract wording. Overall, I think the results continue to look positive. The two new wells on Pine St (MW-12 A and B) have 2 rounds of non-detect this year, except for a J flagged 0.34 ug/L TCE detect (between detection limit and reporting limit) in the water table well in October 2020, so we will need to keep an eye on that. This follows a no-detect in that well when it was sampled in July. Other wells in the Pine Street area (B-5, B-9, B-10, B-11, and the B-2 well nest were "no detect" in October, with the pumping well EXW-4 still detecting low levels of several chlorinateds, including a PAL exceedance (1.3 ug/L) of TCE. Muni Well #4 was no detect for the dry cleaner compounds in October, but the report showed a single chloroform detect that was also J flagged at 1.0 ug/L, and that is likely not from the site.

We'll continue to look at flow and the area around EXW-4, we did perform a top of casing survey for wells near Pine Street and those results showed good comparison to the older survey, but it was good to confirm the elevations.
