Because the Bureau of Solid Waste will not accept the State Lab of Hygiene data for the Superfund Scoring Process, the Bureau of Water Resources will not collect additional sediment samples out of Military Creek. Water Resources understands that Solid Waste will be collecting sediment samples from Military Creek in September of this year; therefore, this would be a duplication of effort. These sediment samples will be analyzed for the same parameters that Water Resources planned to analyze for and will be sent to EPA'S contract lab following proper QA/QC and chain of custody procedures.

The Bureau of Water Resources would be interested in assisting the Bureau of Solid Waste in September. We would like to coordinate sediment sampling so that we can collect sediment for biomonitoring purposes. The analytical results obtained from the EPA contract lab will compliment the biomonitoring. It is also possible that instream biomonitoring equipment could be set up in Military Creek.

We look forward to coordinating this effort with you. I will keep you posted.

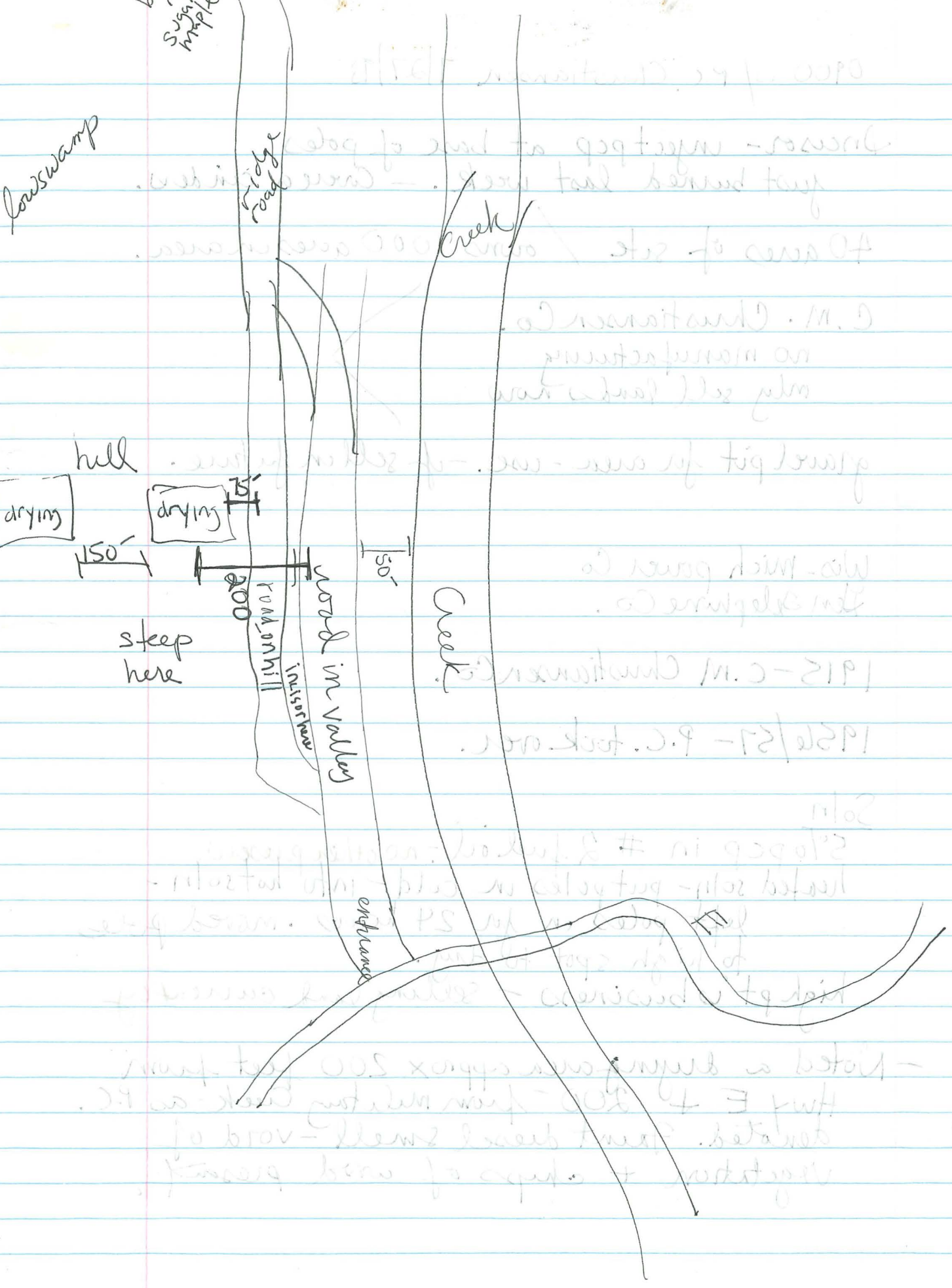
