Was this done under supervision of the D.N.R.?

The old cedar pole yard is on a hill next to what use to be a good trout stream and runs into beautiful North Twin lake. Can you check the area for contaminants?

Also near town, straight West of the First Nation Bank in town, at the waters edge is something draining into the lake. Is it sewerage or a pure water leak?

Thanks for your cooperation in the matter. I do expect action from your department. We love our clean lakes and fresh air, so lets keep it that way.

If this is not looked into, I consider it a pay off.
