The Department of Natural Resources ("the department") is requesting permission to access your property, described above, to sample the potable well serving the property, and to sample and/or abandon existing monitoring wells. Please reference the attached well location figure for your property.

The department previously had an access agreement for sampling the potable well serving your property, and the sampling and abandonment of existing monitoring wells at your property which has since expired. These monitoring wells and the potable well have not been sampled since 2011 and are a part of a groundwater contamination investigation that started in 1987 with the former Lakewood/Pelky DX Station, formerly located on Chain Lake Road.

The department plans to begin work the summer of 2019. DNR staff or their hired contractor will be on-site to collect the groundwater samples and/or abandon the monitoring wells. It is ideal to collect the potable well groundwater sample as close to the pressure tank as possible which means DNR staff will need to enter your home. If you will not be available during the sampling event(s), the samples can be collected from an outside tap; provided that the tap is on and water from that outside tap does not run through a filter system.

You do not need to be home for us to complete groundwater sampling from the monitoring wells. You will be provided with a copy of the analytical results. There will be no cost to you for this work.
