SUBJECT: EPA Removal Activities Update for Aniwa Arsenic Site

Halbur had a brief meeting with Beggs to provide an update. EPA Removal activities began on April 1, 2015. The EPA and their hired contractor were at the site to collect soil samples for waste characterization from Geoprobe direct push soil borings. Warren Hohn – Aniwa Tn’s Environmental Consultant was at the site for assistance and observation. EPA is working with Culligan to integrate the point of entry treatment system with the adjacent property owner’s (Mr. Timm) potable water system. EPA is tentatively scheduling the removal/excavation for the second or third week in May 2015. EPA Removals will discuss with EPA Site Assessment staff and DNR staff to develop a sampling plan for post-excavation sampling.
