Subject: Aniwa Arsenic Site Groundwater Sampling

Hi Warren,

Kathy Halbur was in the office the other day and mentioned to me that you had talked to her about groundwater sampling at the Aniwa Arsenic site. I have been meaning to follow up with you on the annual groundwater sampling and sampling of the private well at the adjacent residence. Based on the groundwater elevations recorded at this site, it appears April to June are when groundwater elevations are at their highest. Therefore, it would be best to conduct annual groundwater sampling during this time. Based on the town's budget, are all the monitoring wells and private well going to be sampled each year? At a minimum, monitoring wells B-12, B-13R, and B-21 need to be sampled to evaluate post-removal action groundwater conditions. The other four remaining monitoring wells on-site that did not have arsenic detections this past sampling round could all be sampled annually or possibly put into a rotation on an annual basis (Example: sample two this year, then the other two the following year). Please propose a groundwater sampling plan to DNR moving forward. If you have any questions or would like to discuss, please feel free to contact me.
