I have reviewed the Construction Documentation Report for the above-referenced site submitted on October 5, 2021. The extension of the clay cap and abandonment of the monitoring wells all seemed to go smoothly. This email can serve as your Notice to Proceed with preparing the case closure request. As a reminder, send any applicable notifications at least 30 days prior to submitting the request.

Additionally, I apologize for not responding previously to the emerging contaminant scoping statement that was included in the Remedial Action Plan submitted on December 22, 2020. I have reviewed the statement with the Peer Committee. The statement is adequate, and sampling is not necessary at this site. As a reminder for other sites, scoping statements should not be only about per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), but should also evaluate if other emerging contaminants like 1,4-dioxane were used. You don't need to update the statement for the Aniwa Arsenic Site, just keep it in mind for other sites.
