Good afternoon,

DNR has contracted with Terracon to visit the site and perform a deeper inspection of each monitoring well. This inspection would involve opening up each well to determine what internal repairs may be needed befor the wells can be sampled at a later date. The inspection will take one day and during that time all the monitoring well locations should be free from materials, vehicles, or other debris that may be covering them. Monitoring well MW-19 located at the western corner of the on-site building does not need to be uncovered because it will be filled and abandoned at a later date. For monitoring wells located inside buildings it can be coordinated that those are opened first so production is not stalled for long.

The inspection is tentatively scheduled for early to mid-July. Let me know if there are any specific dates (besides July 4th) that would **not** work for the inspection to occur on your properties. Reach out with any questions. Thank you,
