- Prepare a Site-Specific Work Plan (SSWP) Addendum for replacement of MW402R, which was inaccessible during the November 2018 semi-annual groundwater monitoring event due to asphalt pavement covering the top of the flush mount well.
- Prepare for semi-annual groundwater monitoring scheduled to be completed May 28th 30th, 2019.
- Prepare for remedial investigation (RI) data summary discussion and completion of RI report pending discussions with USEPA and approval to proceed.
