Good Morning Leah,

Thank you for the opportunity to review and provide comment on the WPSC Green Bay MGP Site Specific Work Plan Addendum 1, dated May 16, 2023. DNR appreciates the effort that went into the work plan and the proposed path forward to evaluate lingering data gaps and uncertainty.

The only comment DNR has is related to the Vapor Intrusion work. DNR recognizes that the building is currently unoccupied, has no operational HVAC system, and the current conditions are not representative of functional building conditions. However, DNR recommends future indoor air sampling paired with sub-slab vapor sampling once there is an operational HVAC and final building redevelopment plans are known; regardless of the results of the proposed sampling. Sampling soil gas and sub-slab vapor at this time while the building is not functional may be delayed until there is an operational HVAC and final redevelopment plans are known. If sampling is conducted at this time, then additional sampling for sub-slab and indoor air will be required once redevelopment plans are known and the HVAC is operational.
