Good Morning Tim,

I left you couple of voice messages to discuss the two projects you inherited from John Hnat. When you have a moment please give me a call. Below is my responses to your questions.

The fence enclosures for borings B-6 and B-11 are scheduled for installation this fall. These borings are located in a very densely wooded area of the landfill and can be accessed for field work during the time when foliage is down (e. g., late fall). The fence installation contractor is tentatively scheduled for late November 2019. We will let you know when the installation is complete.

We are evaluating the landfill site data and in the process of preparing an update report. We hope to complete the report and submit it this winter with recommendations. Would it be possible to apply the review fee toward this update report?

We are also preparing an update report for the Presidio Property and plan on submitting it around the same time.

Hi Mafizul,

I have inherited the Whitefish Bay Village Landfill Site from John Hnat. After reviewing file and I have a few questions for you.

In a WDNR letter dated September 14, 2017, the DNR approved the use of chain link fence enclosures around B-11 and B-6 as an interim measure to address direct contact. Was this implemented? Are the fences up and is there a maintenance plan?

In August of 2018 you submitted an *Additional Sub-Slab Vapor and Groundwater Sampling Update Report* with a \$700 technical review fee for "Other Technical Assistance". This is still an open request. Can you let me know what technical assistance you would like regarding this report, or if you are not looking for any? This way if you need something I can get it out to you, and if not, I can close out the request.

In the NR700.11 semi-annual reporting you note that you are continuing to monitor groundwater for the Site and that a report for the Spring 2019 data is being drafted (I understand that this monitoring is also for the neighboring Presidio Site which I am now the project manager for as well). Can you let me know what the plans are for the Whitefish Bay Landfill site in the future? I assume continued groundwater monitoring. Is there anything else that the city has agreed to or that you have proposed?

If you could get these answers to me when you have the chance it would help greatly. I look forward to working with you on these sites.
